Lal Bahadur Shastri was born in a middle class family. He rose to the high position of the Prime Minister by his sincerity, hard work and sheer merit. Though he was humble he was stern. Though he was soft in talk, he was a strict administrator.

Lal Bahadur Shastri was born on 2nd October, 1904 in Varanasi. He lost his father Sharada Prasad when he was two years old. So he spent his childhood in his maternal grandparents' house along with his mother. He was poor and had to cross the Ganga to go to school. Most of the days he used to swim across the river and attend the classes.

In 1921, he gave up his studies and joined the Non-Cooperation movement. He was jailed for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  years. After coming from the jail, he joined Kasi Vidyapeeth and took the 'Shastri Degree'.
