

## **ARABIC EXAMINATION**

### **INTRODUCTION:-**

Arabic Examination provides opportunities to the students to learn Arabic, Urdu, English & Kannada. Arabic Examination is conducted by board since 1985. The Courses of Arabic Examination are Ustaniya, Foukhaniya, Afzal-UI-Ulma Preliminary(Madhyama), Afzal-UI-Ulma Preliminary(Uttama). The Students should take admission through the recognized schools. The responsibility vests with the DDPI of the Public Instructions of the respective Districts to accord permission & recognition to Ustaniya&Foukhaniya schools. The Minority Director gives permission & recognition to Afzal-UI-Ulma Preliminary Part-I & Afzal-UI-Ulma Preliminary Part-II Madhyama&Uttama Schools respectively. The study materials are prepared by the committee members appointed by the department & the syllabus was approved by Under Secretary, Govt. of Karnataka, Department of Education. KSEEB will have to conduct Examination, Evaluation, announcing results, Issue of Markscards& other related Services. Students shall be admitted to the courses in the beginning of the academic year.

### **USTANIYA COURSE:**

The Ustaniya course is of 02 years. A Pass in Tataniya III Year or Admission tetsts to be held by the School authority are eligible for the admission. Students should have completed 11 years. This course is designed to give sufficient knowledge of Arabic, Urdu, English and Kannada. I Year Examination will be held by the school authority and II Year Examination will be a Public Exam and the examination will be conducted by KSEEB.

### **FOUKHANIYA COURSE:**

This Course is designed to give best knowledge of Arabic, Urdu, English, Kannada& Persian. Foukhaniya course is of 03 years i.e. I Year & II Year Examination will be held by the school authority & III Year Exam will be a Public Exam. A pass in Ustaniya or a pass in VII Std. or Admission test to be held by School Authority are eligible for admission. Student should have completed 13 years.

### **AFZAL-UL-ULMA PRELIMINARY [MADHAYAMA]:**

This course is of 03 Years. This course is designed for those who wish to acquire higher knowledge in Arabic Language, Literature and Culture. A pass in Foukhaniya Examination or Pass in Admission test held by the Institution are eligible for admission to this course. I Year & II Year Examination will be held by the College Authority and III Year Examination will be a Public Exam.

### **AFZAL-UL-ULMA FINAL [Uttama]:**

This course is of 02 years. I Year Examination will be held by the College Authority and II Year Examination will be a Public Examination & it is conducted by KSEEB. This course is designed for those who wish to acquire highest knowledge in Arabic & Persian Language & Literature. The students who have passed Afzal-Ul-Ulma Preliminary courses are eligible to admit the Afzal-Ul-UlmaFinal(Uttama) Courses.

5) Students who have already passed English & Kannada of VII or Standard Public Examination. Either conducted by KSEEB or any other Equivalent Examination, may claim exemption of the above subject in Ustaniya&Foukania Exam respectively.

### **Classification of Students:**

#### **By mode of study**

The students are of three types.

- Regular : Students pursuing education in the recognized Arabic centres opting for recognized Arabic Examination are considered as regular fresh candidates. The duration of courses is One Year.

- Repeater candidates : Student who have failed in the examination may appear for the subsequent examination through the same school. There is no provision for changing the school.
- Private candidates : The private candidates must enroll their names in the Board & should take prior permission to take the examination. The HMs should send the application of the Private candidates along with the enrollment letter.

**Mode of Examination :**

The Arabic Education Examination cover two parts, theory and Oral. Theory Examination will be conducted by the board. The oral examination will be conducted as per the scheduled timetable given by the board.

**Exam Sessions:**

The Examination in Arabic Education shall be conducted once in a year by the KSEEB during the month of February.

**PRE-EXAMINATION PROCESS :-**

Capturing student data for Arabic examination is done through OMR technology. As the printing and scanning of OMR has been out sourced, providing required statistics like number of students under different category is provided by the Board. Scanned data of this OMR shall be used further for all the related processes in the Board.

Following are the pre-examination activities:

1. Publishing Notification regarding Exam fees and other information
2. Sending OMR's to school
3. Verification of check list
4. Verification of center nominal roll
5. Sending of Admission Tickets to schools

**DURING EXAMINATION :-**

Arabic Exam is conducted as per the Time table scheduled by the Board. Exams are conducted under the supervision of DIET Principals by the Senior and Junior Lecturers of various DIETs who are deputed as chief superintendents and custodians of various exam centers. DIET Principals appoint squad Members (Sitting and flying) to visit the Exam centers to avoid

malpractices. Chief Superintendents and custodians get the question paper one hour earlier to exam from the treasury. Chief Superintendents send the answer scripts to the camp officers address on the same day itself through insured post and he/she has to send the absentees Statement, Center Nominal Roll to the concerned Section after the completion of the examination.

**POST EXAMINATION ACTIVITIES :-**

1. Appointment of joint chief, deputy chief and Assistant evaluation
2. Paper valuation in evaluation camps
3. Entry of Marks in Attendance cum marks list (AML) and Evaluation
4. Shifting of answer papers to board
5. Result Announcement
6. Retotaling, Xerox and Revaluation of Answer Scripts
7. Printing of Marks Card and Despatching to the Institutions

**PUBLICATION OF RESULTS**

The final results shall be approved and published by the secondary Education Examination Board soon after the results are processed.

In any case where it is found that the result of the Examination has been affected by error, Director of the Board (OE) shall have power to amend such result in such manner as shall be in conformity with the true position and to make such declaration as he may consider necessary in the behalf, provided that no result of such cases shall be amended after the expiry of 60 days from the date of publication of the results.

In any case where it is found that the result of the examination has been affected by malpractice , fraud, improper conduct, the Board shall have power to amend such result in such manner as it deems fit even after the expiry of 60 days.
