THE DIPLOMA COURSE IN THEATRE ARTS

INTRDUCTION:-

KSEEB is Conducting Diploma in Theater Art Exam since 1992. It gives opportunity to the students to learn skill of acting. It helps the students for self-employment. The courses of Theater Art Exam are theatre concept, History of drama, History of theatre, Acting, stage craft and theatre practice. All those who have completed one year course in Neenasam theater institute are eligible to take the theatre art examination. KSEEB is conducting Diploma in Theater Art Exam every year in the month of May. KSEEB will have to conduct examination, evaluation, announcing result, issue of marks cards and other related services. The syllabus and scheme of examination was approved by the expert committee appointed by the government and it was approved by the commissioner of Kannada and culture department. There is only one Neenasam theater art center in the state i.e., at Heggodu in Shivamogga District.

THE SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

A scheme of examination is hereby formulated to examine and assess the quality of the education and training obtained and absorbed by each of the students who undergo the course in theatre art at the institute.

The viva voce examination shall be of 30 (thirty) minutes each per candidate. It shall be conducted immediately after the last day of the written examination.

ELIGIBILITY:

All those who have completed the one year course at the Neenasam theatre institute are eligible to take the examination. The minimum attendance, required to be eligible to take the examination is 80% of the working days. This may be relaxed up to 5% under special circumstances, for satisfactory reasons, at the discretion of the director.

MINIMUM FOR A PASS:

The minimum for a pass is 40% in theroy 40% in internal assessment and 40% in viva voce. If a candidate fails to secure the minimum in any of the three parts, he/she shall repeat the entire examination.

DECLARATION OF CLASS:

I Class – 60% and above

II Class – 50% and above but below 59%

Pass Class 40% and above but below 49%

DURING EXAMINATION:-

Diploma in Theatre Art Exam is conducted as per the scheduled time table given by the Board. Exams are conducted under the supervision of DIET Principals. Chief Superintendents and custodians will be appointed by the Board. DIET Principals appoint squad Members to visit the Exam center to avoid malpractices. Chief Superintendents and Custodians get the question paper one hour earlier to exam from the treasury. Chief Superintendents send the answer scripts to the camp officers address on

the same day itself through insured post and he/she has to send the absentees Statement, and Center Nominal Roll to the concerned Section after the completion of the examination.

POST EXAMINATION ACTIVITIES:-

- 1. Appointment of joint chief, deputy chief and assistant evaluation
- 2. Paper valuation in evaluation camps
- 3. Entry of Marks in Attendance cum marks list (AML) and Evaluation
- 4. Shifting of answer papers to board
- 5. Result Announcement
- 6. Retotaling, Xerox and Revaluation of Answer Scripts
- 7. Printing of Marks Card and Despatching to the Institutions

Publication of results

The final results shall be approved and published by the Secondary Education Examination Board soon after the results are processed.

In any case where it is found that the result of the Examination has been affected by error, Director of the Board (OE) shall have power to amend such result in such manner as shall be in conformity with the true position and to make such declaration as he may consider necessary in the behalf, provided that no result of such cases shall be amended after the expiry of 60 days from the date of publication of the results.
