4. Read the following passage carefully and answer the questions that follow :

According to a recent study, about 5,00,000 unborn girls are aborted in India every year. Even more disturbing is the fact that 'girl deficit' is more prominent among educated families. The researchers attribute this to the misuse of ultrasound technology for sex determination. Clearly the 11 year old ban of selective abortion of female foetus has not curbed this detestable practice.

The preference for the male child is rooted in the country's old belief, that the son is the old-age security and daughter is someone else's asset. This continues despite the fact that in a growing number of families, at least in urban India, daughters are taking on the responsibilities of looking after parents in their old age. A daughter is considered an economic burden because of the money which has to be spent on her dowry. Human greed and consumerism have made things worse. The argument that it is better to kill the girl in the womb than to kill her for dowry is outrageous. Since the bias against the girl child is based on economic considerations, the solution too will have to be economic. Turning the girl child from an economic liability into an asset is the most effective way of tackling the problem.
